# For Local Groups

## What's Your Why?

This exercise should take about 20 minutes and is a perfect topic for LWML group meetings. Participants are led through a process to help them develop their response to "Why be involved in the LWML?" The resources available are listed below and are all available on at <u>www.lwml.org/AOL</u>.

### For Zones

### Me? A Leader?

This resource would be good to use at a zone board meeting or a zone event. It should take about 40 minutes and details the elements of a good leader, includes how to encourage leaders, and allows for small group discussion.

### Adventures in Planning

This resource is meant to be interactive so there is no PowerPoint or video component. The leader can use the script to direct participants. Supplies needed include sticky notes, and a flip chart or white board. This is a fun exercise that engages participants.

#### **Doctrinal Review**

This presentation reminds us of the importance of having your pastoral counselor (PC) review anything that you publish that contains scripture passages or doctrine. There is a short PowerPoint presentation.

#### Reporting

Whatever resources you choose to use, we ask that you report the activity to District President, Candy Habich, at <u>president@midsouthlwml.org</u>. The information needed is:

- Date of event
- Type of event (local group or zone)
- Who conducted the training (AOL team member, district board member, zone president, etc.)
- Number of participants
- Number of LWML groups represented (if training occurred at a zone event)
- The AOL session topic or topics presented (see list at <u>www.lwml.org/AOL</u>)
- Method or methods used to promote the event (email, Facebook, flyer, word of mouth, other)
- A list of the training topic(s) the participants found most meaningful and why
